Payment and refund policy: All tuition and book fees must be paid in full before the first class, unless a payment plan has been arranged with the CCM Treasurer Nancy Axelrod. Limited scholarships are available and must also be arranged before the commencement of classes. An 80% refund will be issued if you withdraw before the 3rd week of classes; no refunds will be issued after the 3rd class.

- South Jersey Mussar (Haddonfield) -- Tikkun Class** – for students in their 4th and 5th years. The class will meet on Tuesdays from 10:30 am to 12:30 pm, beginning 9/19/17. \$325 per semester. Madricha: Nancy Axelrod. Class full; no new students accepted.
- Penn Valley Tikkun/Advanced Class** – This vaad is continuing and is closed to new students. Madricha: Mindy Shapiro. Class meets Thursdays, 2:00 – 4:00 pm. Class Fee: \$400 including retreat. Madricha: Sonia Voynow. Class full; no new students accepted.
